Indoor painting day at Walton Church. 9.30 am to 1.30 pm. A great opportunity to get together with other members and have a good few hours of painting and socialising .

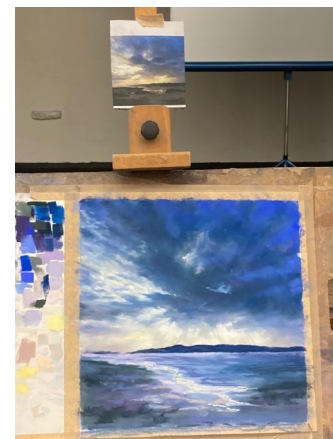
FRIDAY 10th July -

The open gardens were popular again and brought many visitors into the village hall to enjoy the exhibition as well. Unfortunately the social/awards evening was very poorly attended which really let the club down. Anna Louise and her friends came and enjoyed the evening with us. The popular vote was won by Phyl O'Reardon with her fabulous painting of woodland and she was awarded a certificate as her prize. The Polyanna award was won by Amanda Titley for her cute painting of a little dog called Demelza. As Amanda wasn't at the event she was presented with the Polyanna trophy at the next club meeting. 25 artists exhibited 127 paintings and 25 were sold to the value of £1,240. This was up £160 from last year. A very successful exhibition.
